The 2026 edition of the Prize to the Outstanding M.Sc./M.A. Thesis in Cartography, Geodesy and/or Geographic Information Science

The prize is intended to **promote** and **recognize** scientific and academic recent works performed by **Member States** citizens as well as students graduated from accredited programs of any of the official M.Sc./M.A. programmes from universities and other organizations located in any of the **Member States.** The award will be granted in the general subject of Cartography, Geodesy and/or Geographic Information, including any aspects of scientific study such as geospatial information capture, manipulation, presentation and/or dissemination.

The thesis should have been presented between **January 1**st, **2021 and December 31**th, **2025**, and can be written in any language.

In order to apply, the candidate should prepare a summary, in any of the PAIGH **official languages** (english, spanish, french or portuguese), shaped as a scientific paper of no more than 15 pages, including a description of the topic considered, the references considered, a description of the work performed, stating the conclusions and highlighting the importance of the work and its contributions to the development of knowledge or the procedures used. Such summary will be the base of the candidate's evaluation to be performed.

A first prize and up to three mentions will be granted. The document could be published by the Commission journal *Revista Cartográfica*, in the web page of the **Cartography Commission**, or any other means available to PAIGH so the copyright should be transferred.

All those interested should apply with the requested documents between **June 1**st and **30**th, **2026**, using exclusively electronic means.
