# Ph.D. DISSERTATION IN CARTOGRAPHY, GEODESY AND/OR GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SCIENCE

2024 EDITION

The prize is intended to promote and recognize the academic and scientific works performed by graduates from official Ph.D. programs of organizations or universities located in any of the Member States of the Pan American Institute of Geography (PAIGH) or by citizens of those states graduated elsewhere. It will be awarded in the general areas of Cartography, Geodesy and Geographic Information Science, including aspects like capture, manipulation, presentation and dissemination.

The thesis should have been presented between January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 and December 31<sup>th</sup>, 2023, and can be written in any language.

In order to apply the candidate should provide a summary, written in any of the PAIGH's official languages (namely english, spanish, french or portuguese), formatted as a scientific paper of no more than 25 pages including a description of the topic considered, the references considered, a description of the work performed, stating the conclusions and highlighting the

importance of the work and its contributions to the development of knowledge or the procedures used. Such summary will be the base of the candidate's evaluation to be performed.

A first prize and up to three mentions will be granted. The document could be published by the Commission journal *Revista Cartográfica*, the web page of the Cartography Commission, or any other means available to PAIGH so the copyright should be transferred.

All those interested should apply with the requested documents between May 1<sup>st</sup> and 31<sup>th</sup>, 2024 using exclusively electronic means.
