United Nations Permanent Forum  
on Indigenous Issues

On July 28, 2000, the United Nations Permanent Forum was established as an advisory body to the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) of the United Nations (UN). Its objective has been to achieve the full application of the provisions of the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (2007), and ensure its effectiveness, to achieve the in-

tegration of their communities.

The first session was held in May 2002, with annual sessions. Over the years, six priority areas of attention for indigenous populations have been addressed: economic, and social development; culture; environment; education; health, and human rights.

The American Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous

Peoples (2016) recognizes the need to “respect and promote the intrinsic rights of indigenous peoples, which derive from their political, economic and social structures and from their cultures, history and philosophy, especially the rights to their lands, territories and resources”; since their rights constitute a fundamental aspect of historical significance for the pres-

ent and future of the American continent.

Indigenous peoples have the right to their own identity and cultural integrity and to their cultural heritage, tangible and intangible, including the historical and ancestral, as well as to the protection, preservation, maintenance and development of said cultural heritage for their collective continuity and that of its members.

Each session focuses thematically on a specific issue. This year it took place from April 19th to April 30th. The session's name was "Peace, justice and strong institutions: the role of indigenous peoples in implementing Sustainable Development Goal 16."

The COVID-19 pandemic is having dramatic social and economic consequences for indigenous peoples. Among

the inequalities they face every day, some stand out such as water scarcity, loss of linguistic diversity, schools closures and non-existent access to communication technologies, in addition to the interruption of their sources of income.

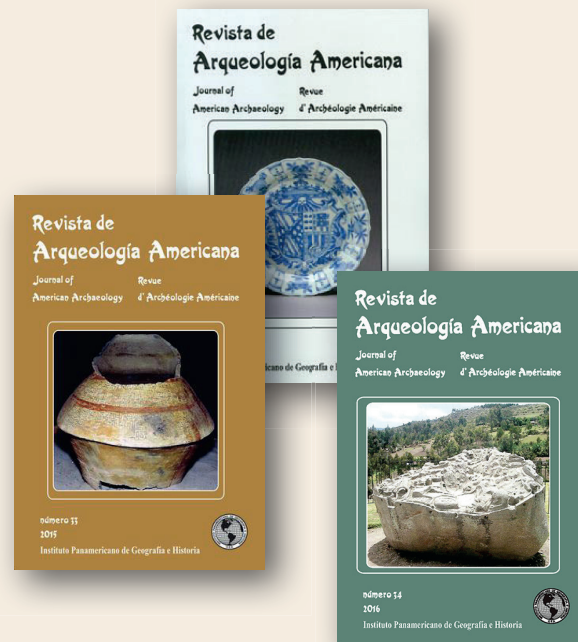

**1924, Peru**

Foundation of the American Popular Revolutionary Alliance

**MAY 8<sup>TH</sup>**

**2018, Costa Rica**

Epsy Campbell becomes the first Afro-descendant woman to take office as Vice-president in a Latin American country.

**MAY 9<sup>TH</sup>**

**1837**

The Peru-Bolivian Confederation is constituted.

**MAY 10<sup>TH</sup>**

**1933**

Paraguay declares war on Bolivia, within the framework of the Chaco War.

**MAY 13<sup>TH</sup>**

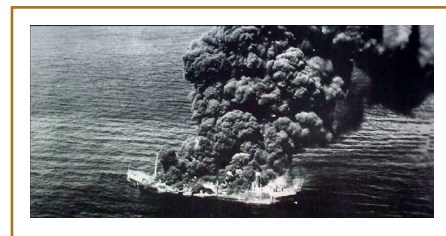
**1888, Brazil**

Abolition of slavery.

**MAY 13<sup>TH</sup>**

**1942, Mexico.**

During World War II, the oil tanker "Potrero del Llano" is torpedoed by German submarines in the Gulf of Mexico off the coast of Florida. Fourteen Mexican sailors perish.



**MAY 16<sup>TH</sup>**

**1825, Bolivia**

The liberator Simón Bolívar decrees the creation of the current Republic.

**MAY 17<sup>TH</sup>**

**1912, El Salvador**

A Legislative Decree adopts the Coat of Arms and the National Flag.

**MAY 20<sup>TH</sup>**

**1902**

Cuba becomes independent from the United States and the Republic is established. Tomás Estrada Palma takes office.

**MAY 21<sup>ST</sup>**

**1851, Colombia**

The Government decrees the abolition of slavery. Afro-Colombian Day is commemorated.

**2001, Nicaragua**

The city of Rivas is declared Historical and Cultural Heritage of the Nation.

**1810, Argentina**
