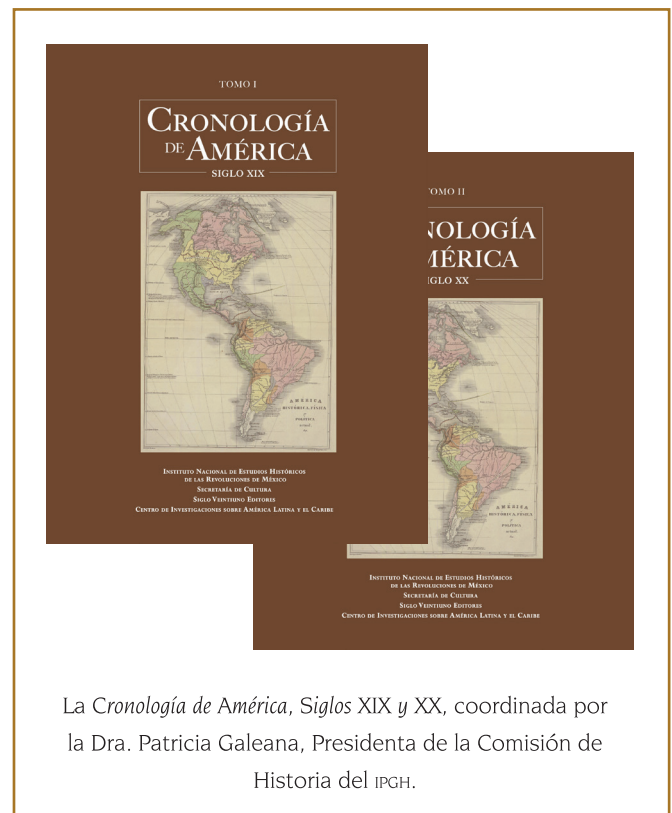
- **THE CHRONOLOGY OF AMERICA REQUESTED IN ALL THE COUNTRIES OF OUR REGION**

Thanks to the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) and the Siglo XXI Editorial, the Chronology of America was published. It was the result of a four-year work of 44 historians.

To this day, it has been presented in Belize, Colombia, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay and the Dominican Republic. The work continues to be requested by all university libraries in the region.

The first presentation was held on May 16th at the Academy of Geography and History of Nicaragua (AGHN). Some of the attendees to the event were the Ambassador of Mexico to Nicaragua, José Omar Hurtado; the President of the Academy of History, Dr. Jaime Incer Barquero, and his Secretary, Dr. Jorge Eduardo Arellano, as well as the Nicaraguan co-authors, Ligia Madrigal Mendieta and Dr. Róger Norori Gutiérrez.

On August 15th, the Chronology of America was presented at the Panama International Book Fair. The session was chaired by the Ambassa-

dor of Mexico to this country, Luis Manuel López Moreno, and Dr. Bolivar Perigault Sánchez, researcher at the University of Panama. The chronology of Panama was made by Dr. Enrique

Camacho Navarro, professor at the Research Center on Latin America and the Caribbean of the UNAM.

In the Republic of Paraguay, the project was presented on October 8th in the National Archive of Asunción, thanks to the sponsorship of the Ambassador of Mexico, Juan Manuel Nungaray, who led the ceremony. The chronology of Paraguay was in charge of the historians: Dr. Herib Caballero Campos, as coordinator; Dr. Juan Bautista Rivarola, Dr. Carlos Gómez Florentín, Dr. Erasmo González and Anahí Soto Vera.

Subsequently, the Chronology of America was presented on October 9th at the Cultural Center of Mexico in Bogotá, Colombia "Gabriel García Márquez" of the Economic Culture Fund. The

event was chaired by Dr. Patricia Galeana, president of the History Commission, Ambassador of Mexico to that country and coordinator of the work, accompanied by the Colombian co-author, Dr. Rodrigo de Jesús García Estrada.

On November 6th, it will be presented in the Dominican Republic, at the Faculty of Humanities of the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo, with the Ambassador of Mexico, Carlos Peñafiel, accompanied by Héctor Luis Martínez, co-author of the Chronology and tenure lecturer of the Dominican History Course in said university.

Also, in November, the Chronology of America will be presented in Belize, thanks to the auspices of the Ambassador of Mexico to that country, Dr. Carlos Quesnel.

1823. Mexico.

Proclamation of the First Federal Republic.



NOVEMBER 3RD

1970, Chile

Salvador Allende takes office.

NOVEMBER 10TH

1821, Panama

The separatist movement of the Spanish Kingdom begins; it is considered the first cry of independence.

NOVEMBER 11TH

1811, Colombia

Cartagena de Indias declares its independence from the Spanish crown.

NOVEMBER 12TH

1838, Nicaragua

The first Political Constitution is approved.

NOVEMBER 13TH

1960, Guatemala

A civil war begins; it will last 36 years, ending on December 29th, 1996.

NOVEMBER 15TH

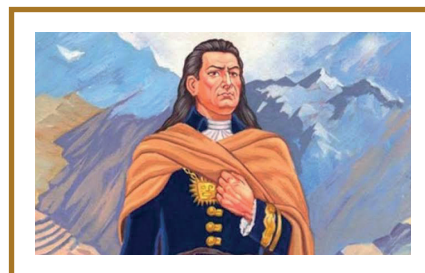
1889

Proclamation of the Republic of the United States of Brazil; name it held until 1968.

NOVEMBER 16TH

1780, Peru

Túpac Amaru II proclaims the abolition of slavery for the first time in the Americas.



NOVEMBER 22ND

1824

Establishment of the Federal Republic of Central America, composed by Guatemala, Honduras, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Costa Rica and the current Mexican state of Chiapas.

NOVEMBER 25TH

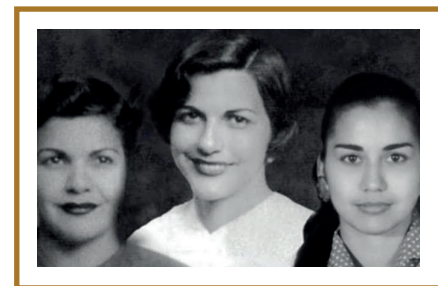
1960, Dominican Republic

The Mirabal sisters are killed by the dictatorship of Rafael Leónidas Trujillo.

NOVEMBER 27TH

1811

Signing of the Act of the Federation of the United Provinces of New Granada.



NOVEMBER 28TH

1821, Panama

Proclamation of independence of the Spanish crown and addition to New Granada then formed by Colombia, Ecuador, Venezuela and Panama.

NOVEMBER 30TH

1898

Dissolution of the United States of Central America.
