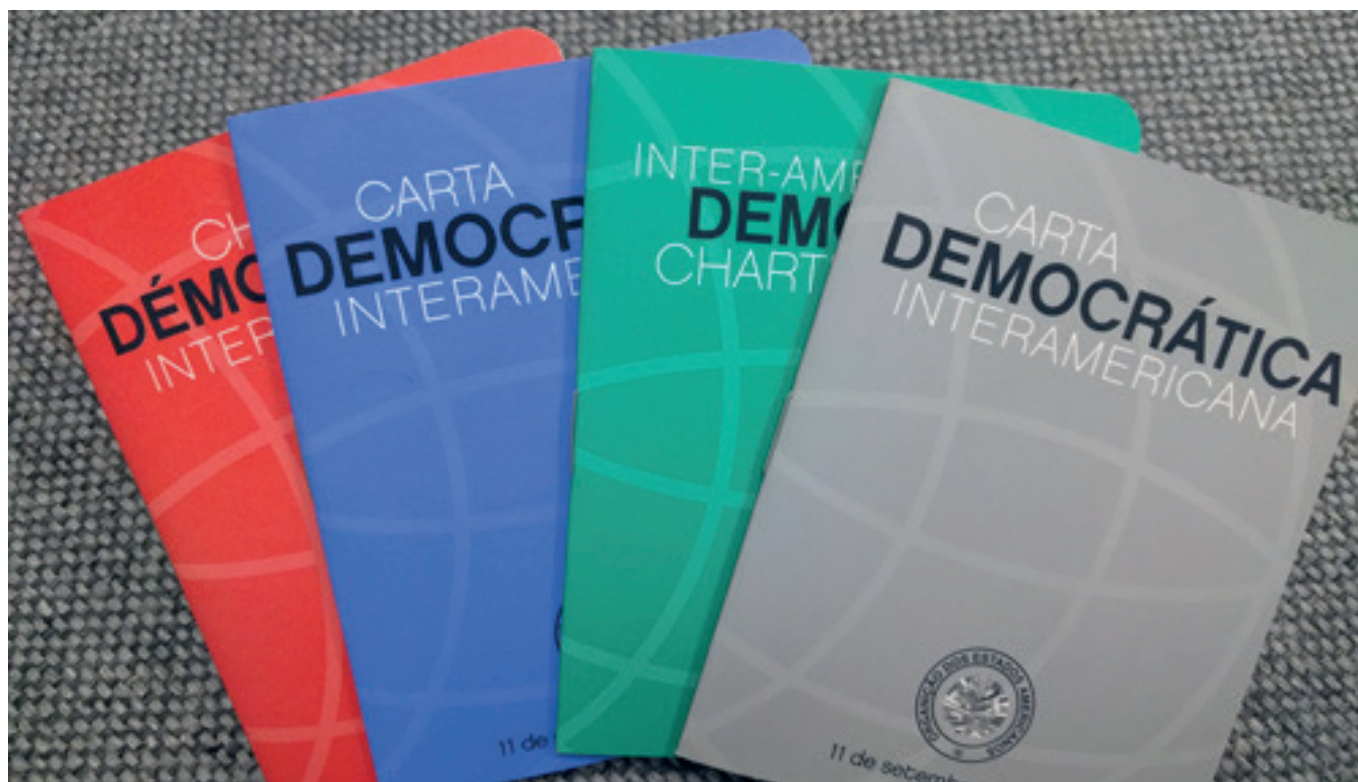

- **INTER-AMERICAN DEMOCRATIC  
CHARTER OF THE ORGANIZATION OF  
AMERICAN STATES**



Historically, the strengthening and effective exercise of democracy has been and continues to be a central topic on the agenda of the Organization of American States (OAS). The Preamble of its constitutive Charter proclaims democra-

cy as an indispensable condition for the stability, peace and development of the continent.

On September 11, 2001, the OAS General Assembly approved the Inter-American Democratic Charter, in Lima, Peru, with the main objective

of strengthening the institutional structure and governance. This document establishes the essential elements of representative democracy: respect for human rights, the separation and independence of public powers, and freedom of speech.

The Inter-American Democratic Charter declares that "the peoples of the Americas have a right to democracy and their governments have an obligation to promote and defend it." The Charter has six chapters and 28 articles:

- I) Democracy and the Inter-American System;
- II) Democracy and Human Rights;
- III) Democracy, Integral Development, and

Combating Poverty;

IV) Strengthening and Preservation of Democratic Institutions;

V) Democracy and Electoral Observation Missions; and

VI) Promotion of a Democratic Culture.

This important document gives the governments of the hemisphere an instrument to guide their collective action in defense of democracy. It is recognized as one of the most complete inter-American instruments for the promotion and strengthening of democratic principles, practices, and culture in the States of America.

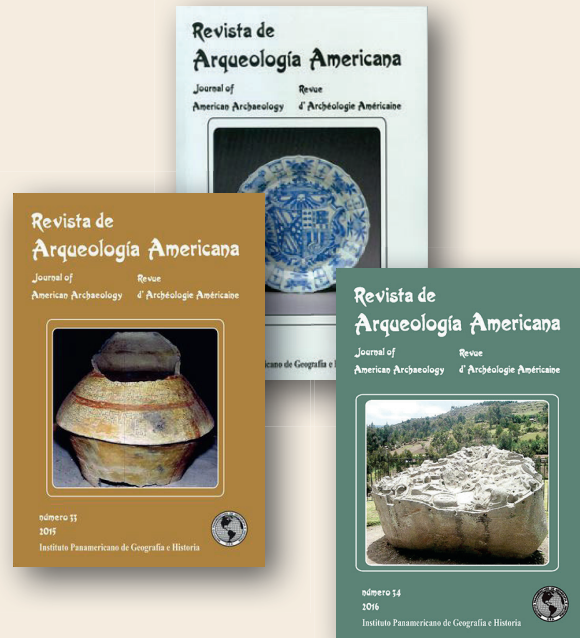

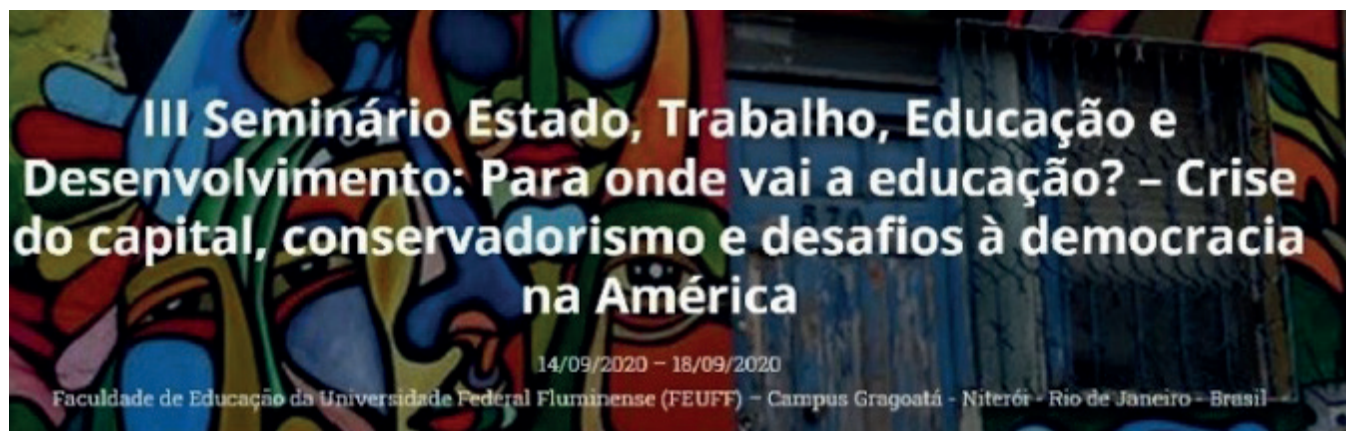

### SEPTEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup>

#### 1999, Panama

Mireya Moscoso becomes the first woman president.



### SEPTEMBER 2<sup>ND</sup>

#### 1947

Signature of the Inter-American Treaty of Reciprocal Assistance (IATRA) in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

### SEPTEMBER 5<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1908, Nicaragua

Creation of the current national Flag and Coat of Arms.



### SEPTEMBER 7<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1822, Brazil

Prince Pedro proclaims the independence. The *United Kingdom of Portugal, Brazil and the Algarve* is dissolved.



### SEPTEMBER 9<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1776

The Second Continental Congress proclaims the

name of the United States of America.

### SEPTEMBER 10<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1823, Peru

The Congress recognizes Simón Bolívar as Liberator of Peru.



### SEPTEMBER 13<sup>TH</sup>

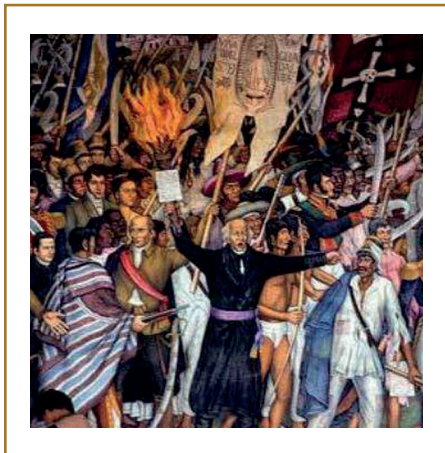
#### 1759, Canada

Battle of Quebec: the British army defeats French forces, which was a decisive victory for the founding of the province.

### SEPTEMBER 16<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1810, Mexico

The Independence movement, led by Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla, begins in Dolores, Guanajuato.



### SEPTEMBER 18<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1810, Chile

Establishment of the First Government Junta. This date is celebrated as the Independence Day.

### SEPTEMBER 21<sup>ST</sup>

#### 1981

Belize becomes independent from the United Kingdom.

### SEPTEMBER 22<sup>ND</sup>

#### 1808, Uruguay

Creation of the Montevideo Governing Board.

### SEPTEMBER 22<sup>ND</sup>

#### 1867, Colombia

Foundation of the National University.



### SEPTEMBER 23<sup>RD</sup>

#### 1811, Argentina

Establishment of the First Triumvirate in the United Provinces of the Río de la Plata.

### SEPTEMBER 23<sup>RD</sup>

#### 1868, Puerto Rico

Grito de Lares: an armed insurrection that sought independence was thwarted by the Spanish-American War.

### SEPTEMBER 23<sup>RD</sup>

#### 1922, Dominican Republic

Signing of the Hughes-Peynado Plan that ends the American occupation.

### SEPTEMBER 24<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1889, Paraguay

Foundation of the National University of Asunción.

### SEPTEMBER 26<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1955, Ecuador

The National Congress proclaims this date as Flag Day.

### SEPTEMBER 29<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1538, Bolivia

Foundation of the city of Sucre, historical and constitutional capital.

### SEPTEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup>

#### 1813, Venezuela

Battle of Bárbula: during the War of Independence, forces of the Second Republic and the army of the United Provinces of New Granada defeat the Spaniards.
