- **PRESENTATION OF THE CHRONOLOGY OF AMERICA IN THE EMBASSY OF MEXICO IN NICARAGUA**

Last May 16, the Academy of Geography and History of Nicaragua (AGHN) and the Embassy of Mexico in Nicaragua, presented the *Cronología de América, siglos XIX y XX*, coordinated by Dr. Patricia Galeana, in which 44 historians all over the continent and the Caribbean participated. This work was published by the UNAM, the Instituto Nacional de Estudios Históricos de las Revoluciones de México and Editorial Siglo XXI.

The event had the honorable presence of the Ambassador of Mexico in Nicaragua, José Omar Hurtado, who highlighted the work of international cooperation for the realization of this work; as well as members of the

The *Journal of Anthropology of the Americas* of the PAIGH invites academics to send thematic dossier proposals for consideration in upcoming editions.

Proposals can be sent to the Journal ([antropologia.americana@gmail.com](mailto:antropologia.americana@gmail.com)) and should include the following information:

1. Name or title of the theme of the dossier.
2. Objectives and justification of the theme (500 words).
3. A provisional list of possible articles that will be included in the dossier, and the names of participating writers, including a brief résumé for each.
4. The résumé of the coordinator of the thematic dossier.
5. The proposals will be considered by the Journal Editorial Committee. Proposals

with an international perspective that include with authors from different regions in Latin America and the Caribbean will be privileged.

6. Once a proposal is accepted by the Editorial Committee, the coordinator (or coordinators) will be responsible for:
  - Posting the 'Call for papers' in collaboration with the Editorial Committee.
  - Contacting potential authors to collaborate on the thematic edition.
  - Carrying out a preliminary evaluation of the papers, together with the Editorial Committee of the journal.
  - Suggesting at least two peer reviewers for each paper.
7. All the articles will be peer reviewed according to the double-blind system.

# UPCOMING ANNIVERSARIES ON THE AMERICAN CONTINENT

**JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup>**  
**1533**

Foundation of the city of Cartagena de Indias, current Colombia.



**JUNE 4<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1932, Chile**

Coup d'etat, also known as the Fall of Montero. Its objective was to overthrow President Juan Esteban Montero.

**JUNE 7<sup>TH</sup>**  
**2006**

Costa Rica and the Republic of China in Taiwan break diplomatic relations, as well as the recognition of the People's Republic of China.

**JUNE 9<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1817, Chile**

The first national currency is minted.

**JUNE 10<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1990, Peru.**

Alberto Fujimori defeats Mario Vargas Llosa in the second round of the presidential elections.

**JUNE 12<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1935**

End of the Chaco War between Bolivia and Paraguay.

**JUNE 13<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1580, Colombia.**

Foundation of the Santo Tomás University, the first in the country.

**JUNE 15<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1924, United States.**

Native Americans are recognized as citizens.

**JUNE 16<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1955, Argentina**

Bombing of the Plaza de Mayo: attempted Coup d'etat by the Armed Forces with the objective of overthrowing President Juan Domingo Perón.

**JUNE 19<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1867, Mexico.**

Maximiliano de Habsburgo is shot in Queretaro.



**JUNE 24<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1821, Venezuela.**

Battle of Carabobo: The patriotic army of Gran Colombia defeats Spain forces.

**JUNE 27<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1973, Uruguay**

Coup d'etat: Juan María Bordaberry dissolves the Senate and Representative Chambers with the support of the Armed Forces.

**JUNE 30<sup>TH</sup>**  
**1520, Mexico**

The Aztecs, governed by Cuitláhuac, expelled from Tenochtitlan the Spanish troops under the command of Hernán Cortés, an event also known as the Noche Triste.
